- 1. DECLARATION OF FAILURE OF BIDDING; AND**
- 2. RECOMMENDATION FOR CONDUCT OF RE-BIDDING**

**FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF PROCUREMENT OF COMPREHENSIVE MAINTENANCE
SERVICE AGREEMENT FOR FM-200 FIRE SUPPRESSION
(PROJECT REFERENCE NO. 2021-SVP-FMFS-061-01)**

WHEREAS, the Power Sector Assets and Liabilities Management (PSALM) Corporation is a government-owned and -controlled corporation duly established under Republic Act (RA) No. 9136 to manage the privatization of assets of the National Power Corporation (NPC) transferred to PSALM with the objective of liquidating all NPC financial obligations in an optimal manner;

WHEREAS, RA 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act, was enacted to modernize, standardize and regulate procurement activities governed by the principles on transparency, competitiveness, system of accountability, public monitoring and streamlined process;

WHEREAS RA 9184 likewise provides that all procurement should be within the approved budget and contained in the approved Annual Procurement Plan (APP);

WHEREAS, on 18 December 2020, the PSALM Board of Directors approved the APP for CY 2021 which includes the Procurement of Maintenance Service Agreement for FM200 Fire Extinguisher with an estimated budget of Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (PHP500,000.00);

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), through BAC Resolution No. SBAC-2021-011, delegated the conduct of procurement for the Procurement of Maintenance Service Agreement for FM200 Fire Extinguisher to the Information Systems and Technology Department (ISTD) as the End-user;

WHEREAS, on 09 September 2021, the PSALM President and CEO approved the Revised APP for the Procurement of Comprehensive Maintenance Service Agreement for FM-200 Fire Suppression (the "Project") with an estimated budget of Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (PHP500,000.00) under the Administration and General Services Division (AGSD), as end-user;

WHEREAS, on 21 September 2021, the pre-procurement conference was conducted wherein the Bids and Award Committee (BAC) approved the Request for Proposal, Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of Two Hundred Ninety-Thousand Pesos (PHP290,000.00) and the timeline for the Project;

WHEREAS, on 24 September 2021, the Invitation to Submit Proposal was posted at the websites of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (<https://www.philgeps.gov.ph>) and PSALM (<https://www.psalm.gov.ph>) and at the PSALM Office for three (3) consecutive days. The Invitation to Submit Proposal was also sent to at least three suppliers of known qualifications;

WHEREAS, on 30 September 2021, no bidder submitted proposals before the deadline for the submission at 10:00 AM;

WHEREAS, Section 35.1(a) of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA 9184 provides that the BAC shall declare the bidding a failure when no bids are received;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, We, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee, **RESOLVE**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to recommend for approval by the Head of the Procuring Entity the following:

1. Declare a **FAILURE OF BIDDING** for the Procurement of Comprehensive Maintenance Service Agreement for FM-200 Fire Suppression; and
2. Conduct a re-bidding for the Project in accordance with the provisions of RA 9184 and its IRR.
