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BAC RESOLUTION NO. SBAC-2021-110

- 1. DECLARATION OF SECOND FAILURE OF BIDDING; AND**
- 2. RECOMMENDATION FOR CONDUCT OF RE-BIDDING**

**FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF SECURITY SERVICES FOR SAN ROQUE MULTI-PURPOSE FACILITIES AND BOUNDARIES
(PROJECT REFERENCE NO. 2021-PB-SS-SRMFB-044-02)**

WHEREAS, the Power Sector Assets and Liabilities Management (PSALM) Corporation is a government-owned and -controlled corporation duly established under Republic Act (RA) No. 9136 to manage the privatization of assets of the National Power Corporation (NPC) transferred to PSALM with the objective of liquidating all NPC financial obligations in an optimal manner;

WHEREAS, RA 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act, was enacted to modernize, standardize and regulate procurement activities governed by the principles on transparency, competitiveness, system of accountability, public monitoring and streamlined process;

WHEREAS, RA 9184 likewise provides that all procurement should be within the approved budget and contained in the approved Annual Procurement Plan (APP);

WHEREAS, on 18 December 2020, the PSALM Board of Directors approved the APP for CY 2021 which includes the Procurement of Security Services for San Roque Multi-Purpose Facilities and Boundaries (the "Project") with an estimated budget of Seven Million Four Hundred Eighteen Thousand Pesos (PHP7,418,000.00);

WHEREAS, on 13 July 2021, the pre-procurement conference was conducted wherein the Bids and Award Committee (BAC) approved the Bidding Documents, the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) in the amount of Seven Million One Hundred Thirty-Three Thousand Pesos (PHP7,133,000.00) and the timeline for the Project;

WHEREAS, on 16 July 2021, the Invitation to Bid for the Project was posted at the websites of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (<https://www.philgeps.gov.ph>) and PSALM (<https://www.psalm.gov.ph>) and at the PSALM office for seven (7) consecutive days;

WHEREAS, on 17 September 2021, the BAC, through BAC Resolution No. SBAC-2021-081, declared a failure of bidding for the Project with Project Reference No. 2021-

PB-SS-SRMFB-044-01 pursuant to Section 35.1(b) of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA 9184 and to conduct a re-bidding in accordance with RA 9184 and its 2016 Revised IRR;

WHEREAS, on 30 September 2021, the pre-procurement conference was conducted wherein the BAC approved the Bidding Documents, the ABC in the amount of Seven Million One Hundred Thirty-Three Thousand Pesos (PHP7,133,000.00) and the timeline for the Project;

WHEREAS, on 05 October 2021, the Invitation to Bid for the Project was posted at the websites of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (<https://www.philgeps.gov.ph>) and PSALM (<https://www.psal.gov.ph>) and at the PSALM office for seven (7) consecutive days;

WHEREAS, on 14 October 2021, the pre-bid conference was held which was attended by six (6) interested bidders, namely: (1) VV Security Agency, Inc.; (2) Topcom Security Agency, Inc.; (3) Grand Meritus Security Agency, Inc.; (4) V8 Security Agency Corp.; (5) Bluforce Security Services, Inc.; and (6) MBG Security and Investigation Services, Inc.;

WHEREAS, on 28 October 2021, the online/electronic submission and opening of bids was conducted and one (1) bidder, Grand Meritus Security Agency Inc. ("GMSAI"), submitted its bids before the bid submission deadline at 9:00 AM;

WHEREAS, GMSAI was rated "passed" during the preliminary examination of the bids and were found compliant with the eligibility and technical requirements as provided in the Bidding Documents;

WHEREAS, the financial bid of GMSAI was likewise found to be compliant and within the ABC, as follows:

WHEREAS, the BAC declared GMSAI as the bidder with the single bid as read, subject to the detailed bid evaluation and post-qualification;

WHEREAS, the BAC, through the Technical Working Group (TWG), conducted a detailed evaluation of the bids with the following results:

WHEREAS, on 02 November 2021, during the presentation of Bid Evaluation Report of the TWG, the BAC observed that the submitted Form No. TEC-04 - Conformity

with Section VI (Schedule of Requirement) and Section VII (Technical Specifications)'s notarial date was one day before the signing date by the authorized representative;

WHEREAS, the BAC, through the recommendation of the TWG, declared GMSAI as disqualified due to non-compliance with the requirement of the Bidding Documents;

WHEREAS, on 03 November 2021, the BAC served the Notice of Disqualification to GMSAI through electronic mail (email) giving it three (3) days within which to submit its Request for Reconsideration (RR) from receipt of notice, which was acknowledged by its Authorized Representative, Ms. Dennis R. Mescallado, on 05 November 2021;

WHEREAS, on 08 November 2021, PSALM received GMSAI's RR dated 04 November 2021 arguing that it should not be disqualified outright since it had faithfully and substantially complied with the minimum requirements as prescribed by the Government Procurement and Policy Board and RA 9184 and its 2016 Revised IRR;

WHEREAS, on 10 November 2021, the BAC denied the RR of GMSAI and informed them that they may file a protest within seven (7) calendar days from receipt of the letter which was delivered to GMSAI office and was received by its Authorized Representative on 11 November 2021;

WHEREAS, PSALM did not receive a protest from GMSAI within the seven (7) calendar days prescribed period;

WHEREAS, Section 35.1 (b) of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184 provides that there shall be failure of bidding if the prospective bidder was declared ineligible;


NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, **We**, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee, **RESOLVE**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to recommend for approval by the Head of the Procuring Entity the following:


1. Declare a **SECOND FAILURE OF BIDDING** for the Procurement of Security Services for San Roque Multi-Purpose Facilities and Boundaries; and
2. Conduct a re-bidding for the Project in accordance with the provisions of RA 9184 and its 2016 Revised IRR.
