## SUPPLEMENTAL BID BULLETIN NO. 1

This Supplemental Bid Bulletin (SBB) No. 1 is issued to clarify items made by the prospective bidders in relation to the Bidding Documents for the Procurement of Supply and Delivery of Neat Diesel Oil for Ilijan Combined Cycle Power Plant (Project Reference No. 2021-PB-NDO-ICCP-009-02)

### **1. Fuel Compatibility Test Method**

For the required fuel compatibility test method under SCC Clause 4, the test method basis will be ASTM D 4740 instead of ASTM D 4570.

### **Petron's Letter dated 16 June 2021**

- 1. With reference to Section VII.-Technical Specifications. Please advise if the attached Cargo Quality Certificate of Neat Diesel Oil is acceptable for your fuel requirements at Ilijan Combined-Cycle Power Plant. Also, we would like to request the Procuring Entity to consider removing the trace metal requirements.***

The Technical Specifications as mentioned in Section VII of the Bidding Documents shall be followed. The personnel/officials of Ilijan CCPP gives the final approval on the submitted Fuel Quality Certificate and deciding on the acceptability of the attached Cargo Quality Certificate would be premature.

On the removal of trace metal requirements, please be informed that inclusion of Trace Metals in the Quality Certificate and/or Certificate of Analysis is mandatory since the contract expressly provides the same in Section VII. Technical Specifications.

Please note that fuel deliveries shall comply with the allowable limit of trace metals as it is required by the Original Equipment Manufacture and non-conformance would compromise the equipment reliability.

- 2. With reference to Section VI. Schedule of Requirements. On the Table of Delivery Points for Bidding, the minimum vessel capacity is 3,000kl which will require draught and LOA measurement of at least seven (7) meters and one hundred (100) meters, respectively.***

***If current draught and LOA are below the recommended dimensions may we request for the timeline of dredging activities and the target draught and LOA measurement of the loading facility post-dredging project.***

Please see attached revised Section IV-A Table of Delivery Points and the history of diesel oil deliveries made to Ilijan CCPP for your reference.

The delivery restrictions or activities related to the start of fuel deliveries shall be discussed in detail with the winning bidder during the kick-off meeting.

Please note that the clarification regarding “Logistics” shall be discussed with the winning bidder, PSALM and Ilijan CCPP during the kick-off meeting prior to the start of the fuel delivery.

- 3. We request to have a site visit at Ilijan Combined Cycle Power Plant on June 22, 2021 (10:00AM). The purpose of this visit is to allow our Marine Safety Group to inspect and evaluate the loading facilities and procedure.***

The site visit has been completed at the requested date and time.

#### **Seaoils’s email inquiry dated 17 June 2021**

- 4. For On-going Government and private contracts - Notice of Award and/or Contract***

***The TOR states that original copies will be presented. Can we present the following as these are only available for said accounts?***

Please be informed that approval/acceptance of the mentioned contracts during this stage of the procurement is not appropriate as it could preempt the post-qualification process.

The bidder may submit other documents that could support the validation of the list of on-going contracts during post-qualification such as Purchase Order, Invoice, Bill of Lading, Inspection and Receiving Report, and Certificate of Acceptance.

- 5. For the SLCC - can the contract be a controlled copy of the Legal Department (Stamped by Seaoil Legal Department)? We have the original copy of the certification of completion.***

The controlled copy of the SLCC may be presented together with the original copy of the Certification of Completion.

All relevant provisions of the bidding documents affected by the above amendments are hereby modified accordingly.
