SUPPLEMENTAL BID BULLETIN NO. 1

This Supplemental Bid Bulletin (SBB) No. 1 is issued to amend and/or clarify items in the Bidding Documents dated 2 July 2020 for the Procurement of Supply and Delivery of Industrial Fuel Oil for Malaya Thermal Power Plant for CY 2020 (Project Reference No. 2020-PB-IFO-MTPP-001-04).

1. AMENDMENT TO THE PROVISION OF THE BIDDING DOCUMENTS DATED 2 JULY 2020

The Bid Data Sheet (BDS) shall be amended to read as follows:

2. CLARIFICATION TO VARIOUS PROVISIONS OF THE BIDDING DOCUMENTS

A. Import Duty by virtue of Executive Order (EO) No. 113, series of 2020

Since the effectivity of Republic Act No. 11469, otherwise known as “Bayanihan to Heal as One Act”, lapsed already on 25 June 2020, EO 113, s. 2020 has also ceased to take effect pursuant to Section 7 thereof. Thus, the Import Duty will be fixed at “0” in the Detailed Bid Price Schedule (Form No. Fin-01A) that will be submitted by the Bidder/s during the bidding.

In view of the above, the Fuel to be delivered shall be free from Import Duty as imposed by EO 113, s. 2020.

All references to EO 113, s. 2020 in the Bidding Documents shall be deemed ineffective accordingly.

B. Import Duty that may be imposed in the future

Should the Government of the Philippines, through an Executive Order or other related issuances, modify the rates of Import Duty on Crude Petroleum Oil and Refined Petroleum Products, particularly Industrial Fuel Oil, during contract implementation, the actual Import Duty shall be indicated in the formulas provided under the Bidding Documents.

Accordingly, pertinent supporting documents should be submitted in addition to the requirements set forth under Clause 10.2 of the Special Conditions of the Contract to facilitate the payment of Import Duty.
