**SUPPLEMENTAL BID BULLETIN NO. 1
FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE SERVICE CONTRACT
FOR THE MALAYA THERMAL POWER PLANT LOCATED AT PILILLA, RIZAL**

1. NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Bidders are hereby notified of the amendments, revisions, modifications and clarifications to the Bidding Documents dated 24 January 2020 for the Procurement of Operation and Maintenance Service Contract for the Malaya Thermal Power Plant located at Pililla, Rizal.

This Supplemental Bid Bulletin is being issued to clarify the documents and specific attachments that must be submitted by the Bidder.

In any case, it is conclusively presumed that the Bidder, in preparing their bids, has taken into account the information and procedures set forth in the ITB.

2. CLARIFICATION TO VARIOUS PROVISIONS OF THE BIDDING DOCUMENTS

A. Notarization/Authentication of Foreign Documents

Section 23.2 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 9184 provides the rules on translation and certification of foreign documents to be submitted by foreign bidders.

By virtue of Resolution No. 13-2019 dated 23 May 2019 promulgated by the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB), Section 23.2 of the 2016 Revised IRR was amended, as follows:

“xxx

However, for Contracting Parties to the Apostille Convention, the documents shall be authenticated through an apostille by the Competent Authority, as defined in Section 8.5.2 paragraph 4 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184, except for countries¹ identified by the DFA that will still require legalization (red ribbon) by the relevant Embassy or Consulate.”

B. Notarization of Bid Securing Declaration

Notarization of the Bid Securing Declaration, or any other documents that is required to be duly notarized, must follow the requirements set forth by Public Act No. 2103, otherwise known as the Notarial Law.

If the Bidder opts to notarize the documents in the Philippines, it must follow the rules provided under Section 1 of Public Act No. 2103. If a foreign bidder decides to notarize the documents in its country of origin, Section 2 of Public Act No. 2103 shall apply.

Pursuant to GPPB Resolution No. 13-2019, Contracting Parties to the Apostille Convention may authenticate their documents through an apostille by Competent Authority except for countries identified by the DFA that will still require legalization (red ribbon) by the relevant Embassy or Consulate.

3. AMENDMENT TO THE PROVISION OF THE BIDDING DOCUMENTS DATED 24 JANUARY 2020

A. Clause 5.4, Section III. Bid Data Sheet shall be amended to read as follows:


5.4	-xxx- For this purpose, similar contracts shall refer to contracts that involve services of similar nature and complexity as to operation and maintenance of either Fossil Fuel-Fired Thermal Power Plant or Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) Thermal Power Plant with generation output delivered to a national grid.
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To:

5.4	-xxx- For this purpose, similar contracts shall refer to contracts that involve services of similar nature and complexity as to operation and maintenance of Fossil Fuel-Fired Thermal Power Plant, Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) Thermal Power Plant or such Power Plant with similar/comparable major plant equipment to Malaya Thermal Power Plant, with generation output delivered to a national grid.
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Please be guided accordingly.
